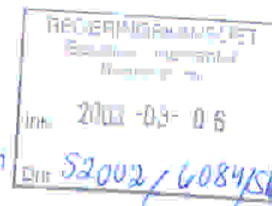

... The curricula vitae of these proposed candidates are enclosed. These candidatures will be considered at the next session of the Governing Council to be held in Lyon, France, on 15 and 16 May 2003.

In addition, subsequent to the deadline of 19 February 2003, the candidature of Professor Anne-Lise Børresen-Dale was received on 26 February 2003. Since this candidature did not meet the deadline established by Rule 46 of the Rules of Procedure of the Governing Council, the Council may wish to consider whether to extend the deadline in order to take the candidacy into account. The curriculum vitae is transmitted herewith.

Participating Countries of the Agency are also informed that in view of the volume of the curricula vitae, only essential data concerning each candidate has been translated. However, the full documentation received is also enclosed in its original language.

In addition, in accordance with paragraph 3 of Rule 46 of the Rules of Procedure of the Governing Council, the Director-General confirms that the present Director of the Agency, Dr Paul H. Kleihues, is not available for reappointment.

The Director-General takes this opportunity to renew to Participating States of the International Agency for Research on Cancer the assurances of her highest consideration.
